Has your family lost KanCare (Medicaid) health insurance?

There's still time to get coverage back.



KanCare renewals are happening quickly. If you, your children, or other members of your household have lost coverage through Kancare, you may actually still be eligible. Know your options for free or low-cost health coverage.

KANCARE ELIGIBILITY

- Adults in families of 4: \$11,400/year
- Infants ages 0-1 in families of 4: \$51,300/year
- Children ages 1–5 in families of 4: \$46,200/year
- Children ages 6–18 in families of 4: \$41,400/year

KANCARE (CHIP) ELIGIBILITY IN KANSAS

• Children ages 0–18 in families of 4: \$76,500/year

If your child has lost Medicaid, contact KanCare CHIP at 800-792-4884 to check eligibility and enroll.

Your children may be eligible for coverage even if you aren't!

- If you believe you or your children are still eligible, contact KanCare by visiting
 https://kancare.ks.gov/home or calling 800-792-4884. You can have your case reconsidered, appeal, or reapply for KanCare.
- Even if you do not think you're eligible, your children may be. It's still important to return all forms as soon as possible. The state can reconsider your case if you turn in your paperwork, even if it's after the deadline.
- If you or your child are no longer eligible for Medicaid and/or CHIP, you may be able to enroll your family in a quality low-cost plan through the Health Insurance Marketplace. Visit https://www.healthcare.gov or call 1-800-318-2596 to get coverage beginning the first of next month.
