Has your family lost Rhode Island Medical Assistance (Medicaid) health insurance?

There's still time to get coverage back.



Rhode Island Medical Assistance renewals are happening quickly. If you, your children, or other members of your household have lost coverage through Rhode Island Medical Assistance, you may actually still be eligible. Know your options for free or low-cost health coverage.

RHODE ISLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY

• Individuals: \$20,120/year

• Adults in families of 4: \$41,400/year

• Children ages 0–18 in families of 4: \$79,800/year

Your children may be eligible for coverage even if you aren't!

- If you believe you or your children are still eligible, contact Rhode Island Medical Assistance by visiting https://staycovered.ri.gov/medicaid-members or calling (855) 840-4774. You can have your case reconsidered, appeal, or reapply for Rhode Island Medical Assistance.
- Even if you do not think you're eligible, your children may be. It's still important to return all forms as soon as possible. The state can reconsider your case if you turn in your paperwork, even if it's after the deadline.
- Most children should remain eligible for RIte Care (CHIP). If your child has lost Medicaid, contact RIte Care at 1-855-697-4347 to check eligibility and enroll.
- If you or your child are no longer eligible for Medicaid and/or CHIP, you may be able to enroll your family in a quality low-cost plan through HealthSource RI. Visit https://healthsourceri.com/ or call (855) 840-4774 to get coverage beginning the first of next month.
