Has your family lost Healthy Connections (Medicaid) health insurance?

There's still time to get coverage back.



Healthy Connections renewals are happening quickly. If you, your children, or other members of your household have lost coverage through Healthy Connections, you may actually still be eligible. Know your options for free or low-cost health coverage.

HEALTHY CONNECTIONS ELIGIBILITY IN SOUTH CAROLINA

- Adults in families of 4: \$20,100/year
- Children ages 0–18 in families of 4: \$63,900/year

Your children may be eligible for coverage even if you aren't!

- If you believe you or your children are still eligible, contact Healthy Connections by visiting
 https://apply.scdhhs.gov/CitizenPortal/
 or calling (888) 549-0820. You can have your case reconsidered,
 appeal, or reapply for Healthy Connections.
- Even if you do not think you're eligible, your children may be. It's still important to return all forms as soon as possible. The state can reconsider your case if you turn in your paperwork, even if it's after the deadline.
- Most children should remain eligible for Partners for Healthy Children (CHIP). If your child has lost Medicaid, contact Partners for Healthy Children at (888) 549-0820 to check eligibility and enroll.
- If you or your child are no longer eligible for Medicaid and/or CHIP, you may be able to enroll your family in a quality low-cost plan through the Health Insurance Marketplace. Visit https://www.healthcare.gov/ or call 1 (800) 318-2596 to get coverage beginning the first of next month.
