- Actively participate in the development and promotion of PediaLink as the American Academy of Pediatrics Online Center for Lifelong Learning
- Support the achievement of the AAP E-Learning goals
- Ensure that content on PediaLink represents the highest quality CME, Continuous Professional Development (CPD), and Maintenance of Certification (MOC) standards
- Actively use all of PediaLink's features and tools
- Contribute to setting programmatic and research priorities for PediaLink and for the AAP Division of E-Learning
- Initiate and facilitate collaborative relationships with groups working on various other AAP initiatives
- Assist in identifying promising opportunities, expert resources, and funds to further the strategic vision and development of PediaLink
- Help promote the development, implementation, and evaluation of PediaLink for FAAPs as a useful everyday tool in continuous learning and for MOC
- Complete thorough and timely reviews of PediaLink deliverables and offer specific suggestions for improvement
- Encourage full implementation of all PediaLink content and features
- Complete PediaLink Editorial Board, Committee, and AAP staff assignments as requested
- Collaborate with members of the PediaLink Residents' and Fellows' Centers to support the growth of PediaLink along the educational continuum for both specialist and generalist FAAPs
- Help collaborate with COMSEP in creating a PediaLink model for medical students to further extend the educational continuum
