The Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) Program helps families thrive.



In a home visiting program, highly trained professionals partner with families to provide personal support from pregnancy through their children's first years of life.



The MIECHV Program provides funding for states to develop and implement evidence-based home visiting programs that improve outcomes for children and families.



Home visiting works. MIECHV programs have demonstrated effectiveness to support child health, well-being, and development.

Child health benefits of home visiting:



MIECHV programs foster child development, promote school readiness and improve long-term academic outcomes, and help parents learn new skills.



81% of MIECHV programs showed improvements in maternal and newborn health.



Home visiting programs connect families to other comprehensive community services and resources, including their pediatric medical home.



Increased support and federal funding for MIECHV would allow home visiting programs to serve additional families and expand its impact.
