

#### US Child and Youth Suicide Deaths by Age Group, <u>Genders Combined</u>, 1981-2021




## US Child and Youth Suicide Deaths by Age Group, Females, 1981-2021




## US Child and Youth Suicide Deaths by Age Group, Males, 1981-2021






#### US Child (Ages 10-14) Suicide Deaths by Gender, 1981-2021


#### US Teenage (Ages 15-19) Suicide Deaths by Gender, 1981-2021




#### US Youth (Ages 20-24) Suicide Deaths by Gender, 1981-2021




## US Children and Youth (Ages 10-24) Suicide Deaths by Gender, 1981-2021




#### US Children and Youth (Ages 0-24) Suicide Deaths by Race/Ethnicity, 1990-2021
