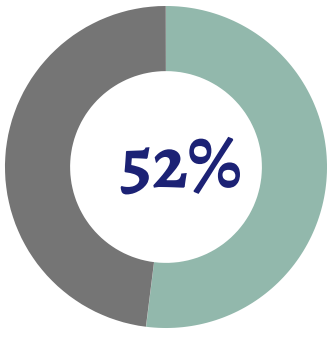

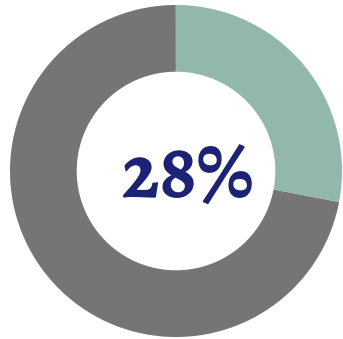

Pediatric Mental/Behavioral Health Priority Training Needs (n=358)

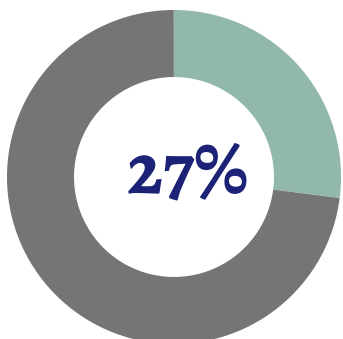
Integration of Mental Health Care into Pediatric Workflow



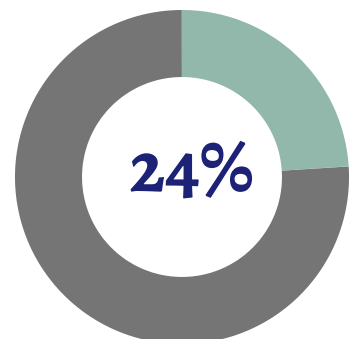
Behavioral Health Concerns Among LGBTQ+ Population

Providing Trauma Informed Care



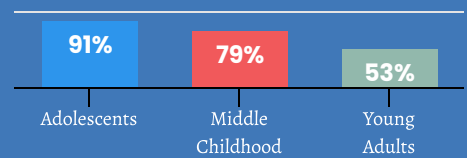
Pediatric Primary Health Care Training Needs (n=235)
