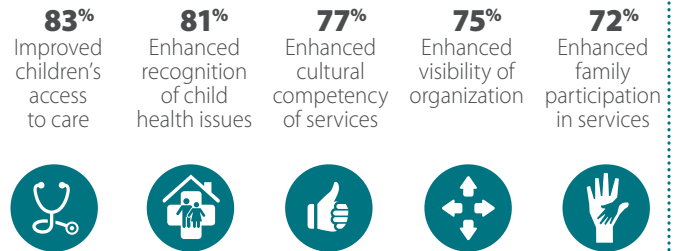
### Types of organizations funded by HTPCP

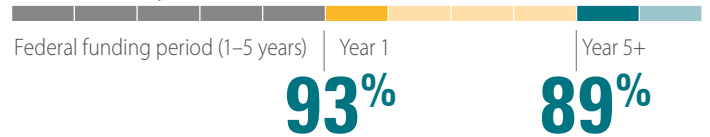

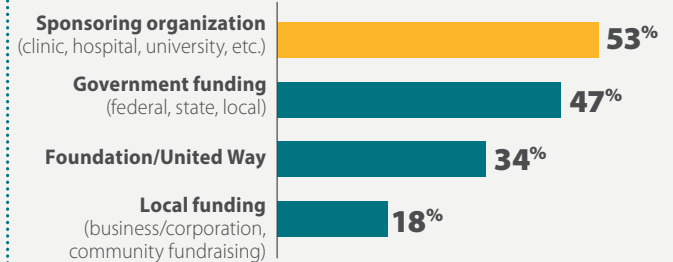

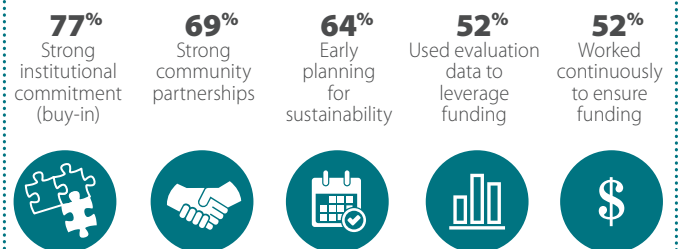
#### Sustainability rates
