2. Click on the AAP Login button.




3. Enter your AAP Login and your password and click the Login button.

RECOVERY PEARLS

- Nutrition
 - >20 grams of protein every 3-4 hours while awake
 - Esp. in the 24-48 hrs after a hard workout
 - Carbohydrates to prevent muscle breakdown
 - No "extra" training on recovery days

ATHLETE'S PLATE

HARD TRAINING / RACE DAY:
