A 15 year old female basketball player presents for a preparticipation physical evaluation. On her history form she reports feeling down or depressed on "most days of the week". On further questioning, she states that this has been increasing over the past several months and notes significant difficulties with sleeping, fatigue, and decreased performance on her travel basketball team. She denies any recognition of other recent changes or stressors. She is doing well academically and socially, and her family relationships appear strong and age-appropriate. She is expected to be the "star player" on her high school basketball team this year, and reports that over the past year she has been "working hard" to achieve this with daily workouts at a local fitness facility, supplemented by several sessions per week with a personal trainer, as well as continued participation with her travel basketball team. She has been trying to lose weight, and has lost 7 pounds over the past 2 months. Her BMI is currently at the 35th percentile. The remainder of her history and physical examination are unremarkable, and her growth and development have been normal to date.

Her mother expresses significant concern over the recent changes in her daughter's personality and energy levels, and reports that she is constantly tired in spite of their best efforts at good sleep habits. She denies significant family history of mental illness, but suspects that her daughter may be depressed and is inquiring about possible antidepressant medications. You advise the mother and daughter that in addition
