A 3-month-old infant is brought to your office because he has been very irritable, and feeding poorly over the past 2 days. He vomited once this morning. The infant has had no fever or symptoms of an upper respiratory infection. He is a full-term infant with no significant past medical history and he has been growing and developing appropriately. His mother just returned to work last week and his father, who is unemployed, has been caring for the infant during the day. She thinks that the baby's fussiness may be due to the recent change in his routine.

In your office, the baby's vital signs include a temperature of 37.2°C, heart rate of 160 beats/min, respiratory rate of 36 breaths/min, and pulse oximetry of 96% on room air. On physical examination, the baby is very fussy and the mother is having difficulty consoling him. There are several circular bruises on his right forehead and left forearm. The remainder of his physical examination is unremarkable. His mother denies any history of trauma.

You advise the baby's mother that he should undergo further evaluation in the emergency department because of his
