When considering what audiences are in-scope vs out of scope, consider **whether or not the target audience is a member of the health care team in a health care setting.**

Family members of patients/Visitors of <u>inpatient healthcare facilities</u>

Out of Scope
Teachers/Parents/Students
Infection Preventionists
Epidemiologists
Microbiologists
People who are incarcerated
Homeless shelter non-clinical staff/people who use shelter services
