

AAP E-Cigarette and Vaping ECHO

The American Academy of Pediatrics is recruiting up to 15 primary care practices to join a 6-month learning collaborative aimed to improve access to evidence-based clinical interventions that address youth e-cigarette use. Practices will engage in ECHO (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes) model™, a telementoring platform that leverages video conference technology to connect primary care teams in local communities with subject matter experts, fostering an “**all teach, all learn**” approach. Participating practice teams will test, implement and disseminate strategies that lead to improved engagement with adolescents (age 13-21) around e-cigarette use and prevention. Pediatric practices interested in developing sustainable approaches to improve adolescent health are encouraged to apply.

Benefits of participating:

- ✓ Improve access to quality care for adolescents who are at risk of using e-cigarettes.
- ✓ Increase knowledge regarding best practices for addressing adolescent e-cigarette use.
- ✓ Learn new quality improvement (QI) methods and track improvement through monthly data collection to achieve desired outcomes in your practice
- ✓ Network and problem solve with others

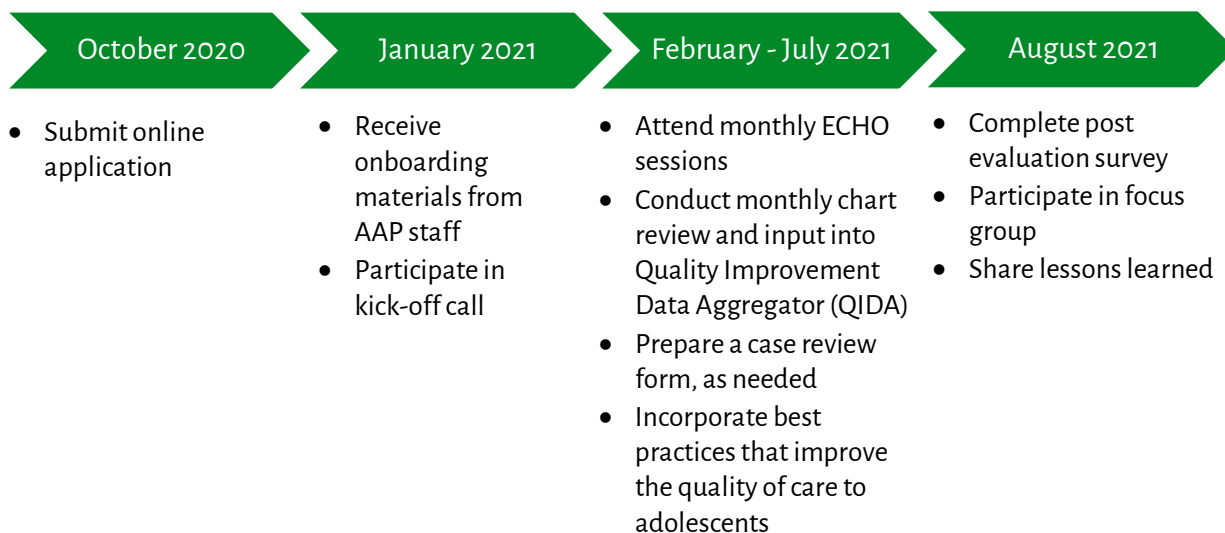
Participating pediatricians will have the opportunity to earn American Board of Pediatrics Part 4 Maintenance of Certification (MOC) credit as well as continuing education credits

Who should apply:

Practices providing primary care who:

- ✓ Care for patients ages 13-21 and want to improve the quality of care they receive related to e-cigarettes
- ✓ Can assemble a team of members that may include at least one primary care physician, one nurse, and one additional team member, such as a front office or practice manager staff member
- ✓ Provide primary care to patients 13-21 years of age
- ✓ Can participate in one virtual meeting per month from 3-4p CT between February – July 2021
